Trisha has also written and produced at least 10 one-woman shows over the last 10 years. These range from tours of
 Joyce Grenfell monologues and songs to a gritty piece on the Industrial Revolution to satirical entertainment with the
 1950's as the theme. She is particularly into the 1950's - not just the music but also the social history - and the women's
 role! Trisha is also involved in a number of projects with Hampshire County Council Arts and Heritage department.....
 this is a flexible and highly experienced performer whose capacity to entertain is second to none.

Trisha is an actor first and a singer second. Yes - she can sing beautifully - but she can do more than sing
 - she can perform a song. She can also provide so much more than the singing. She can host an event, provide
 links, DJ, perform comedy sketches, create audience participation - you give the brief and it's more than
 likely Trisha will be able to fulfil it!
